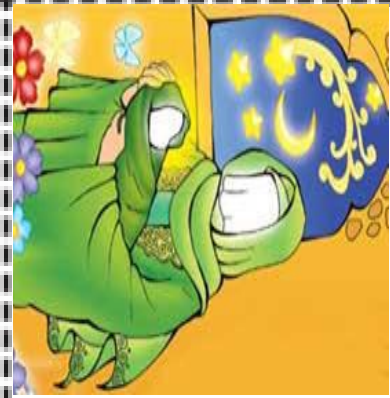
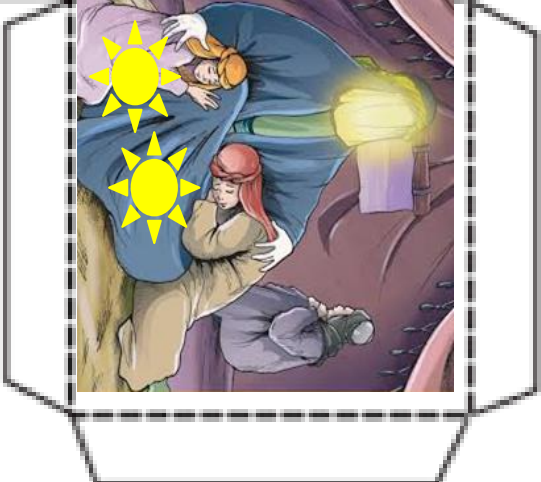
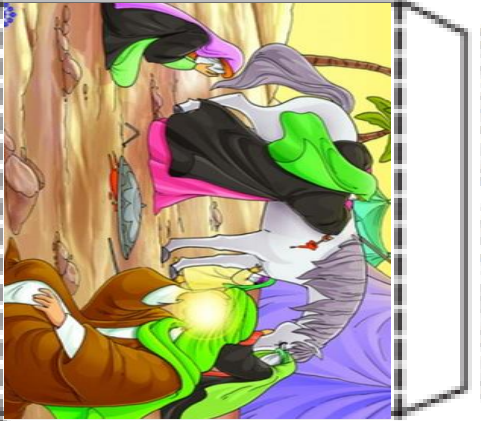
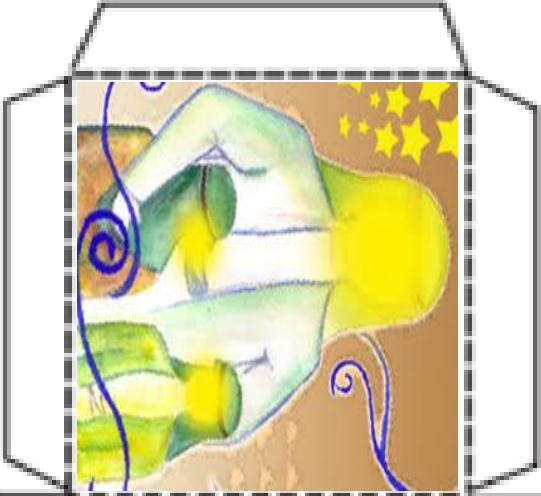
Picture below depicts the series of events in the life of Sayyedah Zainab (sa). Observe the picture carefully and chose any one scene to discuss and share with your family...

She is known as شريكة الحسين because she was with Imam Hussain (as) throughout the journey along with her two sons Aun and Muhammad

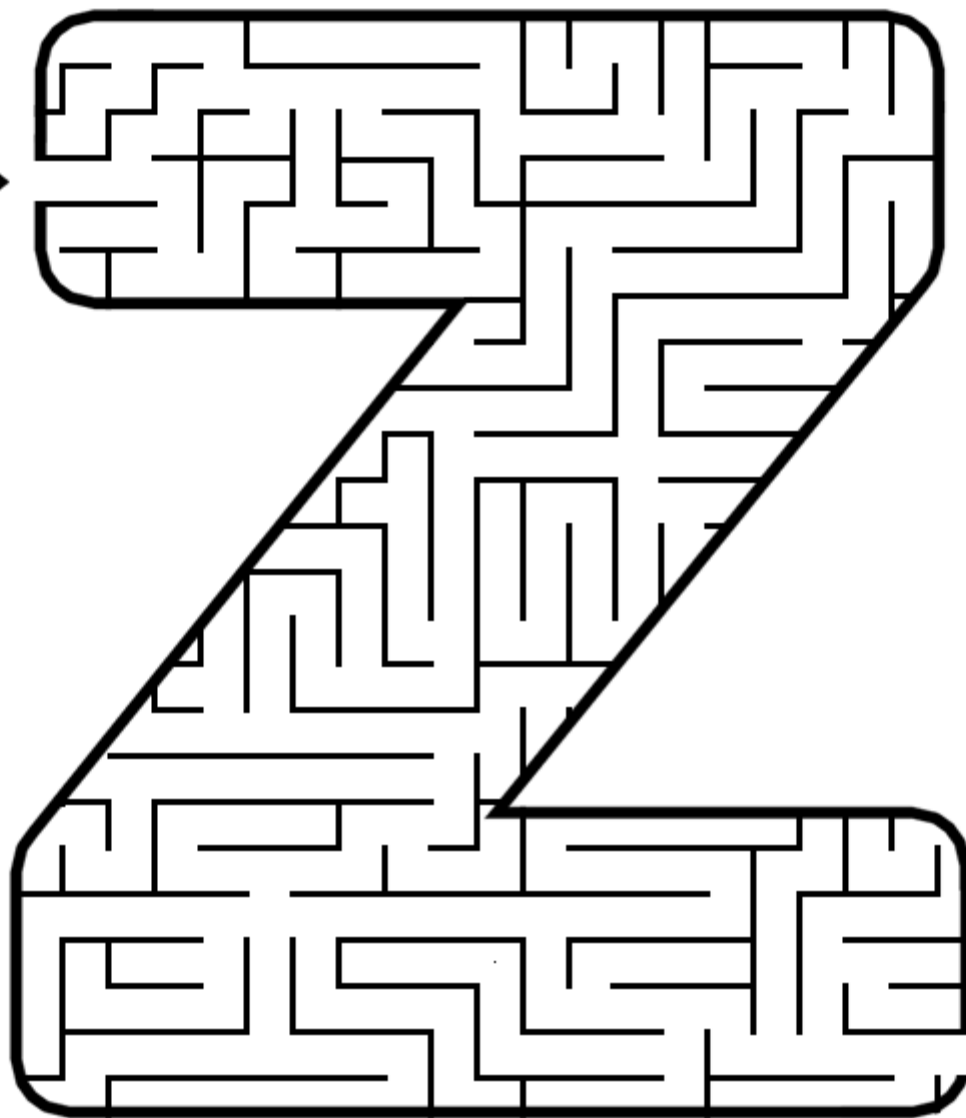
Bibi Zainab (sa) was wise and shared her knowledge with others
